Agreed summary of the meeting	
<p>Selection of candidates for election to an LCG, so that we do not end up carrying 'passengers', candidates will need to have expressed an interest in being an active LCG member.</p> <p>Therefore, membership of the church community would be the qualification to vote for LCG candidates, rather than being listed on the electoral roll.</p> <p>To move up to become a PCC member would require the candidate to be on the roll.</p> <p>The LCGs are to have responsibility for growing the Church locally, with PCC support</p> <p>Discussed the issue of where people can be buried within the enlarged Pastrow parish. Requires further clarification as to legal entitlements - if a single Parish is a Parishioner entitled to be buried in any of the graveyards in the Parish? If so this may cause problems with space etc.</p> <p>Agreed that the Incumbent will have the final decision in the event of a difficulty with decision making within an LCG (e.g. a hung vote).</p>
